INTRODUCTION

This finding aid was prepared by the staff of the McGill University Archives between May and October 2004. Final editing of the finding aid was completed by Johanne Pelletier, Director and University Archivist, and Shannon Hodge, Contract Archivist. Assistance regarding the translation and interpretation of Hebrew texts was provided by Deborah Abecassis (McGill University Department of Jewish Studies) and Bonnie Goodman, Contract Archivist.

The finding aid is organized into two major sections: 1) a file listing by container and 2) a file listing by series. Physically, the vast amount of textual material is located in containers 1-4; the photographs and negatives in containers 5-6; and oversized materials (both textual and photographic) in containers 7-8. BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION:

Abraham de Sola

Abraham de Sola was born in 1825 in London to David Aaron de Sola, Cantor in the Bevis-Marks Synagogue, and Rica Meldola, daughter of prominent publisher and scholar, Raphael Meldola. Abraham de Sola moved to Montreal in 1847 upon accepting the position of Reverend of the Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue (Shearith Israel), Canada's oldest synagogue. Over the ensuing fifty-seven years, de Sola carved out a career and reputation as a leading scholar and leader of the Jewish community; not only in Canada but also in the United States.

Abraham de Sola was known as an eloquent and prolific lecturer as well as a man of broad interests. During his long career, de Sola addressed the Montreal Mercantile Library Association, the Montreal Literary Club, the Numismatic and Antiquarian Society of Montreal, the Montreal Mechanics Institute, and the Natural History Society of Montreal (of which he served as president from 1867-1868). Many of his speeches and sermons, delivered in English, were published in periodicals and the contemporary Jewish press. Although he was chiefly concerned with the reconciliation of religion and science, the articles' diverse subjects reflect the eclectic nature of his intellectual interests.

In 1848, a year after arriving in Canada, McGill College appointed Abraham de Sola as lecturer in Hebrew and rabbinical literature, and in November 1853 a professor of Hebrew and Oriental literature; a position he held until his death in 1882. He also taught philology and Chaldean and Spanish language at McGill, as well as Hebrew at Presbyterian College. Abraham de Sola wrote medical studies on the rabbinical dietary laws and the use of anesthetics which appeared in major medical journals and were reprinted as pamphlets. After the publication of his authoritative study *Sanatory Institutions* in 1858, McGill made him a Doctor of Laws (honoris causa), making de Sola the first Jew to receive the honor in any English-speaking country. While at McGill, he worked closely with eminent scientists Sir William Dawson and Sir William Edmond Logan.

In addition to his publications, Abraham de Sola became a book distributor in 1873 with his brother-in-law Jesse Joseph, purchasing the copyright of prominent lecturer and minister Isaac Leeser's translation of the 24 books of the Holy Scripture as well as the distribution and copyright of a long list of works issued by Rabbi Isaac Leeser's Philadelphia publishing house.

As a minister of the Shearith Israel congregation, Abraham de Sola established a Sunday School (1849), a private Jewish day and boarding school for boys and girls (1854), helped establish the Young Men's Hebrew Benevolent Society (1863), the Yod Beyod, or Jewish Mutual Aid Society (1863) and the Ladies' Hebrew Benevolent Society (1877). As member of the Ancient Jewish Order of Keshet Shel Barzel, de Sola assisted in the establishment of the order's first Canadian lodge in 1872. This was named after de Sola as a tribute to his distinguished career. de Sola has the distinction of being the first British subject to open the United States House of Representatives with prayer on January 9th 1872.

Abraham de Sola's oldest son, Aaron David Meldola (1853-1918), succeeded him as the reverend of the Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue in Montreal and another son, Clarence Isaac (1853-1920), was one of the founders of Zionism in Canada and functioned as the president of the Federation of Zionist Societies from 1899-1920. Clarence Isaac was also responsible for the creation of the Jewish National Fund and fundraised for the creation of a Jewish state in Israel.

Evelyn Miller

Evelyn Miller was Abraham de Sola's great-grand-daughter. Born in August 1916 to Marguerite Mendes and Samuel Silver, she married Emmanuel Miller and had two children, Rica Judith and Jonathan Miller. She died at the age of seventy-nine in Montreal in May 1996. Evelyn Miller worked as an archivist, historian, collector and writer, focusing on the history of Canada and Montreal's Jewish communities. Her research, archival initiatives and writing also centered on the history of her own family genealogy, including the de Solas, Harts, Davids and Josephs, each of which are founding families of Canada's Jewish community.

Evelyn Miller's matriarchal lineage included the Mendes and de Sola families. The de Sola's can be traced to the ninth century with settlement on the Iberian Peninsula. After expulsion from Spain, the de Solas first settled in Amsterdam and then England, where David Aaron de Sola (Reverend Abraham de Sola's father) was a cantor at the Shearith Israel (London).

Despite not having earned a university degree, Evelyn Miller achieved considerable success as a writer, historian and archivist. Her education included completion of the Carleton University Summer archival studies program and a fellowship to Union Theological Seminary. In the 1960s Evelyn Miller co-authored "Spanish & Portuguese Synagogue (Shearith Israel) Montreal, 1768-1968", with Esther Blaustein and Rachel Esar. The article was published in the Jewish Historical Society of England's *Micellanies Par VIII*, and was written in honor of the congregation's bicentennial. Evelyn Miller also wrote the history of the Golden Age Association, and the Young Man's and Women's Hebrew Association, both affiliated organizations of the Canadian Jewish community. Her publications include numerous scholarly journal articles, as well as newspaper articles appearing in *The Canadian Jewish News*. Evelyn Miller's writing on her own family history included "Enter the Jew: The Jews of Quebec 1759-1882", written in the 1970s and published in the *Jewish Historical Society of Canada's Journal* (Spring 1978). This work recounted the history of early Canadian Jewish families focusing on the Harts, de Solas and Josephs.

Among Evelyn Miller's archival legacies is her active collection and care of the de Sola papers as they related to her family and McGill University, a collection she loaned to the McGill University Archives for the purposes of microfilming in 1973. This project resulted in her collaboration with the McGill University Archives on *The Microfilm Guide to the Abraham de Sola Papers*, published by the McGill University Archives in 1973. Evelyn Miller maintained an active presence in community and cultural organizations, working as a volunteer with the McCord Museum, the Canadian Jewish Congress Archives, and the Montreal Jewish Historical Society. She was also honorary archivist for Montreal's Jewish Public Library (JPL) throughout the 1970s.

Throughout her career as an archivist and researcher Evelyn Miller maintained a correspondence with some of the most prominent institutions and scholars in the field of Jewish history. Among these contacts include: Jacob Radar Marcus, Jonathan Sarna, Bernard Wax, (Director of the American Jewish Historical Society), as well Rabbi Jonathan Plaut from the Congregation Beth El of Windsor. Evelyn Miller's research also led to correspondence with various research institutions and libraries including the Historian's office of the U.S. Department of State, the Chief of the House Library, U.S. House of Representatives, the U.S. Library of Congress, the National Archives of Canada, and the National Library of Canada (now the Library and Archives of Canada).

EXTENT: 1.3m of textual records. – 180 photographs.

CUSTODIAL HISTORY:

The records were created and collected by Evelyn Miller and remained in her custody until her death in 1996. At this date they were transferred to her estate under the care of her family in Montreal. Previous to this, Miller had agreed to have selections of the de Sola materials microfilmed at the McGill University Archives in 1973 in conjunction with the production of a finding aid for the microfilm. The fonds, including both her research papers and the original de Sola materials, were donated to the McGill University Archives in November 2002.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

Fonds consists of correspondence, research and genealogical notes, articles produced by Evelyn Miller's activities as a researcher, historian, writer and archivist. There is also a considerable amount of primary source material collected by Evelyn Miller on her family; particularly correspondence, sermons and articles relating predominately to Abraham de Sola but also to David Aaron de Sola (Abraham's father), Aaron David Meldola de Sola, Clarence Isaac de Sola and the Hart family. The fonds have a vast amount of photographs mostly of the de Sola Family, but also the David, Hart and Joseph families. The fonds is composed of the following series:

ARRANGEMENT NOTE: The documents are presented in their original order as received by McGill University Archives.

LANGUAGE: English, French, and Hebrew. File titles are in English.

RESTRICTIONS: None.

SERIES 1 DESCRIPTION

SERIES 1: Original Historical Records (de Sola, Hart, Joseph)

DATES: 1794-1920

EXTENT: Approximately .7 m of textual records. – 180 photographs.

SCOPE AND CONTENT: Series consists of original records relating primarily to the Hart, Joseph and de Sola families; however, materials relating to the de Sola family dominate the series. Includes records relating to Abraham de Sola, Abraham's father David Aaron de Sola as well as Abraham's sons Aaron David Meldola de Sola and Clarence Isaac de Sola. Also includes records of the early Hart family, mostly concerning Aaron Hart and the family's settlement in Trois-Rivières, Quebec.

The documents primarily include correspondence to and from Abraham de Sola and to a lesser extent his sons Aaron David Meldola & Clarence Isaac de Sola. There is some early correspondence by David Aaron de Sola, Abraham de Sola's father. As well, the series includes personal correspondence between Abraham de Sola and his wife Esther Joseph de Sola and their children (particularly Aaron David Meldola and Clarence Isaac).

Abraham de Sola's correspondence relates to his work as reverend of the Shearith Israel (Montreal) synagogue; Professor of Oriental Languages at McGill University; and as a lodge member of the Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel, to which he gave his name to its first Canadian lodge in 1872, the De Sola Lodge no. 89. There is extensive correspondence relating to the lodge as well as other lodges in the order, the majority located in the United States. The correspondence relating to Abraham de Sola's professorship at McGill University includes a number of letters from Principal William Dawson.

The correspondence in the fonds related to David Aaron Meldola de Sola focuses on his assuming the position of Reverend of the Shearith Israel (Montreal) Synagogue upon his father's death in 1882, and includes a number of handwritten and printed sermons given to the congregation. The correspondence and documents relating to Clarence Isaac de Sola focuses mainly on his role as the president of the Federation of Zionist Societies of Canada from 1899 to 1920. This includes sermons, conference proceedings, as well correspondence between Clarence Isaac de Sola and the leader of the Zionist movement, Theodore Herzl.

SERIES 2: Research and Professional Activities

DATES: 1959-1996

EXTENT: Approximately .6 m of textual records.

SCOPE AND CONTENT: Series consists of records reflecting Evelyn Miller's pursuit of her historical, genealogical, professional and related interests. The records focus on Evelyn Miller's research activities including documents relating to her genealogical research, research for her historical writing, and research correspondence.

Included are documents relating to research used in her publications and articles, as well as drafts of these articles in various stages of editing. These articles and publications most notably include: "Spanish & Portuguese Synagogue (Shearith Israel) Montreal, 1768-1968" published in the Jewish Historical Society of England's *Micellanies Part VIII*, "Enter the Jew: The Jews of Quebec 1759-1882", and *The Microfilm Guide to the Abraham de Sola Papers at McGill University* (1973). This series also includes selected printed material relating to the Montreal-based Spanish and Portuguese (Shearith Israel) Synagogue, the Shaar Hashamayim Synagogue, and the Golden Age Association, all as it derived from her research interests.

CONTAINER 1

1. Small English dictionary, inscribed "G. de Sola" 1882

File consists of a small English Dictionary entitled *Handy Dictionary Illustrated* (Wood, John Marshall. *A Handy Dictionary of the English Language*. New York: Published for the Trade 1880, copyright 1879). The inside front and back covers include handwritten names and addresses written on both sides.

2. Book, [A Morsel of Bread]. – Rabbi Elisa Habillo. – Hebrew 1794

File contains a printing of Rabbi Elisha Habillo's work 'A Morsel of Bread' [English translation of title], written in Hebrew. The book was published by in Livorno [Leghorn], Italy in 1794 by Raphael Meldola (1754-1828), Abraham de Sola's maternal grandfather. The book is a description of the grace and blessings that should be used in conjunction with meals as well as any rules that accompany these blessings. Also included in the book is a clipping from 1850 from the *Jewish Chronicle* authored by D. Meldola regarding the work of scholar Philoxène Luzzato. This "D. Meldola" is possibly David Meldola (1797-1853), eldest son of Raphael Meldola and a co-founder of the *Jewish Chronicle*. An English translation of the book's title page is provided in the file.

3. Exercise books of Aaron David Meldola de Sola 1860-1868

File consists of Aaron David Meldola de Sola's exercise books used to practice penmanship and record short stories and grammar exercises. Also includes bookkeeping ledgers (1867-1868).

4. Autograph book of Hannah Kellert 1881

File consists of Hannah Kellert's autograph book with entries dated between 1881-1884 and 1896-1897. The book also contains a more contemporary Valentine's Day card unaddressed.

5. Lectures by Abraham de Sola 1853-1874

File consists of published Sermons given by Abraham de Sola including his Valedictory Address to the Graduates in Arts (University of McGill College), 1864.

6. de Sola family and business correspondence 1848-1913

File consists of personal and family correspondence from Esther and Abraham de Sola and their children as well as business related correspondence to both Abraham and Aaron David Meldola de Sola. A number of the items are encapsulated for preservation purposes.

**7. Archival records – family history of the de Sola, David, and Hart families
n.d.**

File consists of original records reflecting the genealogy of the de Sola, Hart, and David families (created between the ca1870 and 1904). Also included are E. Miller's notes reflecting her accumulation of these materials.

8. Exercise books – Abraham de Sola

1840-1860

File consists of Abraham de Sola's exercise books, including a Hebrew transcription of "The Book of Esther for the Feast of the Lots & Service for the first night of Passover." Also includes penmanship exercises and other writings such as a draft pamphlet by de Sola on Hebrew grammar.

9. Newspaper Clippings: Announcements

1839-1969

File consists of newspaper clippings, primarily obituaries dated 1839 to 1969.

10. Sermons by D.A. de Sola, Meldola de Sola & Others

1831-1905

File consists of original handwritten sermons by David Aaron de Sola, Abraham de Sola and Aaron David Meldola de Sola, including the following by D.A. de Sola: "A sermon of the Excellence of the Holy Law and the Necessity and Importance of Religious Instruction Delivered at the Synagogue of the Spanish and Portuguese Congregation in London, 26th March, 1831" and "A Sermon Delivered at the Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue, Beavis Marks on Wednesday, 7th Nissan (24th March), 5607 [1847],". By Meldola de Sola: "The Duty of Orthodox Congregations A Sermon Preached before the Congregation "Shearith Israel," New York, in the Synagogue, West Nineteenth Street, On Sabbath Shemoth, Tebeth 23rd 5648, January 7, 1888," and "Zionism A Sermon Delivered by the Rev. Meldola de Sola of Montreal, on the seventh day of Passover 5660," [1900]. One sermon is typed, "A Good Name Sermon delivered Heshvan 20th (Nov. 14th) 5669 in the Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue Montreal by Rabbi de Sola (Saturday, November 14, 1908).

11. Book: *Way of Faith* by Rev. Dr. R. Meldola

1848

File consists of small book entitled *Way of Faith, A Moral and Religious Catechism of the Principles of the Jewish Faith* by Rev. Dr. R. Meldola. This text was translated from the Hebrew by the Rev. D. Meldola (Rabbi, Spanish and Portuguese Jews' Synagogue), published London by Meldola & Berlandina in the year 5609 [1848].

12. Corporation of Portuguese Jews of Montreal and Indenture of late Arthur Wellington Hart

1841-1857

File consists of original records including the By-Laws for the Corporation of Portuguese Jews of Montreal, 14th Hesvan, 5618 [1857], and the "Indenture of late Arthur Wellington Hart" dated 1841.

13. Clarence de Sola: Banquet, Addresses, Correspondence

1900-1919

File consists of materials relating to Clarence de Sola and the Federation of Zionist Societies of Canada. Includes a letter written by de Sola, an invitation to the Banquet of the Federation of Zionist Societies of Canada, and published versions of Clarence de Sola's Presidential Addresses for the Federation of Zionist Societies of Canada for the years 1913, 1917, and 1919.

14. Address by Alan Judah Hart, Trois-Rivières, Quebec

n.d.

File consists of two addresses by Alan Judah Hart typed with handwritten notes in the margins.

15. Presentation booklet, Rev. David de Sola Pool 1935

File consists of a booklet with embroidered cover presented to Rev. David de Sola Pool on his fiftieth birthday, dated 1935.

16. Scrapbook of Clippings, de Sola Lodge #89 By-Laws 1889-1912

File consists of a scrapbook of clippings dated from 1889-1912. There are, as well, three published copies of the By-Laws of the De Sola Lodge, No. 89 Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel. Revised and passed the 20th October, 1889. 25 Tishri, 5650.

17. Diary, David. A. Hart 1898-1915

File consists of a handwritten diary presumed to have belonged to David A. Hart (based on entries and personal information reflected in the entries). The diary begins on May 5 1898 "...as a result of an interesting talk with Clarence de Sola...". The diary begins again with entries in 1906.

18. Clippings de Sola and Hart ca1850-1920

File consists of newspaper clippings primarily on Abraham de Sola, as well as the Harts and Josephs, including a magazine article on Jesse Joseph's Montreal house, Dilcousa.

19. Clippings: Mendes Family, Birth of Marguerite 1890

File consists of newspaper clippings relating to the Mendes Family. There is also a certified copy of Marguerite Rachel Mendes' birth certificate from the State of New York. Marguerite was the daughter of Leonard Mendes and Rica de Sola. There is also a letter from the Department of Health, City of New York (Office of the Commissioner) on health care for babies.

20. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola 1833-1849

File consists of original correspondence with Abraham de Sola. There is also de Sola's fire insurance policy (1849). Most of Abraham de Sola's correspondence is related to his position as Reverend at Shearith Israel (Montreal) but also includes a letter from Abraham de Sola's mother to his father who had been in Amsterdam on business (dated Tuesday, August 13th, 1833).

21. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola 1850-1859

File consists of original correspondence with Abraham de Sola. Some of the correspondence refers to de Sola's appointment as Professor of Hebrew and Oriental Literature at McGill College in 1848, as well as a letter announcing that he had received a Doctor of Laws (honoris causa). The remainder of the correspondence is related to de Sola's position as Reverend of Shearith Israel (Montreal).

22. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola 1860-1869

File consists of original documents and correspondence relating to and with Abraham de Sola. All the correspondence is of a professional nature. Additional documents include receipts for his son's Stationary Drilling and Gymnastics at the High School Department of McGill College for 1864-1865, 1867, a petition to the Province of Quebec, published sermons, bills/invoices for personal items, a report card for Meldola de Sola from the Catholic Commercial Academy dated December, 1861, and receipts for donations made.

23. Correspondence Abraham de Sola**1870-1871**

File consists of original correspondence with Abraham de Sola, including communications with The Natural History Society and the Numismatic and Antiquarian Society of Montreal, Principal William Dawson of McGill University, and references to de Sola's opening of the U.S. Congress. Also included are Aaron David Meldola de Sola's examination booklet from the High School Department of McGill University, Session 1869-1870, pamphlets, financial records from the "School for Young Ladies, conducted by Miss Symmers and Miss Smith," and correspondence from various associations and societies.

24. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola**1872-1873**

File consists of original correspondence with Abraham de Sola, including letters from various societies and associations, and Principal William Dawson. Also includes a dance card for the Purim Ball 5632 (25 March 1872), real estate publicity, and records related to the Grand Lodge, Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel of the Atlantic Coast established 5632 [1872].

25. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola**1873**

File consists of original documents and correspondence with Abraham de Sola. The majority of the documents and correspondence relates to the de Sola Lodge No. 89 and the Grand Lodge, Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel.

26. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola**1874**

File consists of original documents and correspondence with Abraham de Sola. The majority of the documents and correspondence relates to the de Sola Lodge No. 89 and the Grand Lodge, Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel located in various Canadian cities as well as the United States. There are numerous exchanges of correspondence between Abraham de Sola and Alex Miller, as well as a M. Solomon, concerning the Lodge.

27. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola**1875**

File consists of original documents and correspondence with Abraham de Sola. The majority of the documents and correspondence relates to the de Sola Lodge No 89 and the Grand Lodge, Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel. A portion of the correspondence is between the City of Hamilton's lodge and Abraham de Sola, as well as the Wall of Zion Lodge in Toronto.

28. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola**1876-1879**

File consists of original correspondence with Abraham de Sola, including communications with Principal William Dawson of McGill University and other officials of McGill University concerning faculty business and affairs. There is some correspondence from various congregations and from a benevolent society. A large portion of the correspondence is between Abraham de Sola and the Alliance Israelite Universelle in Paris. Also included is a letter from de Sola's sons, Gershom and Clarence Isaac.

29. Correspondence, concerning Abraham de Sola's Illness in Europe 1877

File consists of original correspondence with Abraham de Sola, primarily concerning his illness while in Europe. Also included is a letter from the Board of School Commissions Portuguese Congregation of Montreal, as well there is a large card from the Yad B' Yad Society.

30. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola 1880-1882

File consists of original correspondence and other materials relating to the Sir Moses Montefiores Charity, the President James Abram Garfield Memorial Fund, and communications with the Athenaeum Bureau of Literature, New York. Correspondence includes communications on religious questions, and the Grand Lodge, Ancient Jewish Order of Keshet Shel Barzel and an exchange between Abraham de Sola and his nephew Harry.

31. Assorted Correspondence, de Sola family 1858-1913

File consists of original correspondence of Aaron David Meldola de Sola; including ecumenical letters dated 1885 to 1903 from churches and abbeys. Also included are legal documents relating to Aaron David Meldola and Esther de Sola acting as the Executors of Abraham de Sola's estate, handwritten sermons and addresses by Aaron David Meldola de Sola entitled "Sermon at the laying of the Corner Stone of the Stanley Street Synagogue of the Montreal Spanish and Portuguese Congregation "Shearith Israel" on Thursday Tishri 4th 5648 - Sept 22nd, 1889,"; "Address to the Wilfred Laurier March 15th, 1906," and "Barmitzvah Address to Philip Hart and Willie Solomon, Shabat Hanuckah, 5661".

Also includes documents and correspondence relating to the de Sola Lodge No. 89 and the Grand Lodge, Ancient Jewish Order of Keshet Shel Barzel, correspondence from Philadelphia concerning benevolent societies, and a pamphlet relating to "Rev. Dr. Lilienthal's Hebrew, Commercial, and Classical Boarding School."

33. Correspondence, Sir Moses Montefiore to Abraham de Sola 1862-1888

File consists of original correspondence mostly from Sir Moses Montefiore to Abraham de Sola.

34. Testimonial Letters for Abraham de Sola 1845-1850

File consists of a small notebook containing testimonial letters about Abraham de Sola's abilities as the Reverend of the Shearith Israel Synagogue (Montreal). Also included is a letter from Abraham de Sola's father (Rev. D.A. de Sola) regarding his candidature to the Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue in Montreal.

35. Opening of U.S. Congress by Abraham de Sola

1874

File consists of original correspondence with Abraham de Sola regarding his opening of the United States Congress in prayer in 1872. Also includes newspaper clippings related to this event.

36. Correspondence Abraham de Sola, Meldola de Sola

1873-1882

File contains correspondence to Abraham de Sola from the Grand Lodge, Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel and communications concerning Aaron David Meldola de Sola's succession as Reverend of Shearith Israel (Montreal) following his father's death in 1882. As well, there is a handwritten copy of an article from the *Canadian Illustrated News* dated 17 July 1882 on the same topic.

41. Estate of Miss Fanny David 1907

File consists of original documents relating to the estate of Fanny David, including financial matters, bills for the funeral, and a will.

File consists of an Israel Government Coin in honor of Israel's 25th Anniversary in 1974, a photo reproduction of an engraving of David David, *Royal Insurance Company Fire & Life Almanac 1868* (with Meldola de Sola's name signed on top), an envelope filled with dry flowers, a wedding invitation for Ethel Hart's wedding, and two small notes written by Aaron David Meldola de Sola about his father's death.

File consists the Letters Patent de Terrier for a certain part of the fief and seigneurie of Becancour. This was awarded to Samuel Becancour Hart of Three Rivers in 1845 by the province of Canada.

45. Dedication Ceremonies Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue Sermons – Aaron David Meldola de Sola 1887-1894

File consists of original correspondence with and sermons by Aaron David Meldola de Sola, including the sermon commemorating the 125th anniversary of the foundation of Kahal Kadosh Shearith Israel of Montreal (30 Dec. 1893), the sermon and dedicatory prayer delivered at the consecration of the Stanley Street Synagogue of Kahal Kadosh Shearith Israel of Montreal (31 Aug. 1890) and correspondence from Aaron David Meldola de Sola from the Congregation Shearith Israel, New York, New York.

File consists of original correspondence and documents relating or written by the Josephs, Harts and de Solas. There is some correspondence between Evelyn Miller and David de Sola Pool, Rev. of the Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue of New York. 1968-1982

File consists of correspondence relating to E. Miller's research of the de Sola and Joseph families and includes correspondence with their descendants.

Meldola" is possibly David Meldola (1797-1853), eldest son of Raphael Meldola and a co-founder of the *Jewish Chronicle*. An English translation of the book's title page is provided in the file.

3. Exercise books of Aaron David Meldola de Sola 1860-1868

File consists of Aaron David Meldola de Sola's exercise books used to practice penmanship and record short stories and grammar exercises. Also includes bookkeeping ledgers (1867-1868).

4. Autograph book of Hannah Kellert 1881

File consists of Hannah Kellert's autograph book with entries dated between 1881-1884 and 1896-1897. The book also contains a more contemporary Valentine's Day card unaddressed.

5. Lectures by Abraham de Sola 1853-1874

File consists of published Sermons given by Abraham de Sola including his Valedictory Address to the Graduates in Arts (University of McGill College), 1864.

6. de Sola family and business correspondence 1784-1913

File consists of personal and family correspondence from Esther and Abraham de Sola and their children as well as business related correspondence to both Abraham and Aaron David Meldola de Sola. A number of the items are encapsulated for preservation purposes.

7. Archival records – family history of the de Sola, David, and Hart families **n.d.**

File consists of original records reflecting the genealogy of the de Sola, Hart, and David families (created between the ca1870 and 1904). Also included are E. Miller's notes reflecting her accumulation of these materials.

8. Exercise books – Abraham de Sola **1840-1860**

File consists of Abraham de Sola's exercise books, including a Hebrew transcription of "The Book of Esther for the Feast of the Lots & Service for the first night of Passover." Also includes penmanship exercises and other writings such as a draft pamphlet by de Sola on Hebrew grammar.

9. Newspaper Clippings: Announcements **1839-1969**

File consists of newspaper clippings, primarily obituaries dated 1839 to 1969.

10. Sermons by D.A. de Sola, Meldola de Sola & Others **1831-1905**

File consists of original handwritten sermons by David Aaron de Sola, Abraham de Sola and Aaron David Meldola de Sola, including the following by D.A. de Sola: "A sermon of the Excellence of the Holy Law and the Necessity and Importance of Religious Instruction Delivered at the Synagogue of the Spanish and Portuguese Congregation in London, 26th March, 1831" and "A Sermon Delivered at the Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue, Beavis Marks on Wednesday, 7th Nissan (24th March), 5607 [1847],". By Meldola de Sola: "The Duty of Orthodox Congregations A Sermon Preached before the Congregation "Shearith Israel," New York, in the Synagogue, West Nineteenth Street, On Sabbath Shemoth, Tebeth 23rd 5648, January 7, 1888," and "Zionism A Sermon Delivered by the Rev. Meldola de Sola of Montreal, on the seventh day of Passover 5660," [1900]. One sermon is typed, "A Good Name Sermon delivered Heshvan 20th (Nov. 14th) 5669 in the Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue Montreal by Rabbi de Sola (Saturday, November 14, 1908).

11. Book: *Way of Faith* by Rev. Dr. R. Meldola **1848**

File consists of small book entitled *Way of Faith, A Moral and Religious Catechism of the Principles of the Jewish Faith* by Rev. Dr. R. Meldola. This text was translated from the Hebrew by the Rev. D. Meldola (Rabbi, Spanish and Portuguese Jews' Synagogue), published London by Meldola & Berlandina in the year 5609 [1848].

12. Corporation of Portuguese Jews of Montreal and Indenture of late Arthur Wellington Hart **1841-1857**

File consists of original records including the By-Laws for the Corporation of Portugese Jews of Montreal, 14th Hesvan, 5618 (1857), and the "Indenture of late Arthur Wellington Hart" dated 1841.

13. Clarence de Sola: Banquet, Addresses, Correspondence **1900-1919**

File consists of materials relating to Clarence de Sola and the Federation of Zionist Societies of Canada. Includes a letter written by de Sola, an invitation to the Banquet of the Federation of Zionist Societies of Canada, and published versions of Clarence de Sola's Presidential Addresses for the Federation of Zionist Societies of Canada for the years 1913, 1917, and 1919.

14. Address by Alan Judah Hart, Trois-Rivières, Quebec **n.d.**

File consists of two addresses by Alan Judah Hart typed with handwritten notes in the margins.

15. Presentation booklet, Rev. David de Sola Pool **1935**

File consists of a booklet with embroidered cover presented to Rev. David de Sola Pool on his fiftieth birthday, dated 1935.

16. Scrapbook of Clippings, de Sola Lodge #89 By-Laws **1889-1912**

File consists of a scrapbook of clippings dated from 1889-1912. There are, as well, three published copies of the By-Laws of the De Sola Lodge, No. 89 Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel. Revised and passed the 20th October, 1889. 25 Tishri, 5650.

17. Diary, David. A. Hart **1898-1915**

File consists of a handwritten diary presumed to have belonged to David A. Hart (based on entries and personal information reflected in the entries). The diary begins on May 5 1898 "...as a result of an interesting talk with Clarence de Sola...". The diary begins again with entries in 1906.

18. Clippings de Sola and Hart **ca1850-1920**

File consists of newspaper clippings primarily on Abraham de Sola, as well as the Harts and Josephs, including a magazine article on Jesse Joseph's Montreal house, Dilcousa.

19. Clippings: Mendes Family, Birth of Marguerite **1890**

File consists of newspaper clippings relating to the Mendes Family. There is also a certified copy of Marguerite Rachel Mendes' birth certificate from the State of New York. Marguerite was the daughter of Leonard Mendes and Rika de Sola. There is also a letter from the Department of Health, City of New York (Office of the Commissioner) on health care for babies.

20. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola **1833-1849**

File consists of original correspondence with Abraham de Sola. There is also de Sola's fire insurance policy (1849). Most of Abraham de Sola's correspondence is related to his position as Reverend at Shearith Israel (Montreal) but also includes a letter from Abraham de Sola's mother to his father who had been in Amsterdam on business (dated Tuesday, August 13th, 1833).

21. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola **1850-1859**

File consists of original correspondence with Abraham de Sola. Some of the correspondence refers to de Sola's appointment as Professor of Hebrew and Oriental Literature at McGill College in 1848, as well as a letter announcing that he had received a Doctor of Laws (honoris causa). The remainder of the correspondence is related to de Sola's position as Reverend of Shearith Israel (Montreal).

22. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola**1860-1869**

File consists of original documents and correspondence relating to and with Abraham de Sola. All the correspondence is of a professional nature. Additional documents include receipts for his son's Stationary Drilling and Gymnastics at the High School Department of McGill College for 1864-1865, 1867, a petition to the Province of Quebec, published sermons, bills/invoices for personal items, a report card for Meldola de Sola from the Catholic Commercial Academy dated December, 1861, and receipts for donations made.

23. Correspondence Abraham de Sola**1870-1871**

File consists of original correspondence with Abraham de Sola, including communications with The Natural History Society and the Numismatic and Antiquarian Society of Montreal, Principal William Dawson of McGill University, and references to de Sola's opening of the U.S. Congress. Also included are Aaron David Meldola de Sola's examination booklet from the High School Department of McGill University, Session 1869-1870, pamphlets, financial records from the "School for Young Ladies, conducted by Miss Symmers and Miss Smith," and correspondence from various associations and societies.

24. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola**1872-1873**

File consists of original correspondence with Abraham de Sola, including letters from various societies and associations, and Principal William Dawson. Also includes a dance card for the Purim Ball 5632 (25 March 1872), real estate publicity, and records related to the Grand Lodge, Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel of the Atlantic Coast established 5632 (1872).

25. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola**1873**

File consists of original documents and correspondence with Abraham de Sola. The majority of the documents and correspondence relates to the de Sola Lodge No 89 and the Grand Lodge, Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel.

26. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola**1874**

File consists of original documents and correspondence with Abraham de Sola. The majority of the documents and correspondence relates to the de Sola Lodge No 89 and the Grand Lodge, Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel located in various Canadian cities as well as the United States. There are numerous exchanges of correspondence between Abraham de Sola and Alex Miller, as well as a M. Solomon, concerning the Lodge.

27. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola**1875**

File consists of original documents and correspondence with Abraham de Sola. The majority of the documents and correspondence relates to the de Sola Lodge No 89 and the Grand Lodge, Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel. A portion of the correspondence is between the City of Hamilton's lodge and Abraham de Sola, as well as the Wall of Zion Lodge in Toronto.

28. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola

1876-1879

File consists of original correspondence with Abraham de Sola, including communications with Principal William Dawson of McGill University and officials of McGill University concerning faculty business and affairs. There is some correspondence from various congregations and from a benevolent society. A large portion of the correspondence is between Abraham de Sola and the Alliance Israelite Universelle in Paris. Also included is a letter from de Sola's sons, Gershom and Clarence Isaac.

**29. Correspondence, concerning Abraham de Sola's Illness in Europe
1877**

File consists of original correspondence with Abraham de Sola, primarily concerning his illness while in Europe. Also included is a letter from the Board of School Commissions Portuguese Congregation of Montreal, as well there is a large card from the Yad B' Yad Society.

30. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola

1880-1882

File consists of original correspondence and other materials relating to the Sir Moses Montefiores Charity, the President James Abram Garfield Memorial Fund, and communications with the Athenaeum Bureau of Literature, New York. Correspondence includes communications on religious questions, and the Grand Lodge, Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel and an exchange between Abraham de Sola and his nephew Harry.

31. Assorted Correspondence, de Sola family

1858-1913

File consists of original correspondence of Aaron David Meldola de Sola; including ecumenical letters dated 1885 to 1903 from churches and abbeys. Also included are legal documents relating to Aaron David Meldola and Esther de Sola acting as the Executors of Abraham de Sola's estate, handwritten sermons and addresses by Aaron David Meldola de Sola entitled "Sermon at the laying of the Corner Stone of the Stanley Street Synagogue of the Montreal Spanish and Portuguese Congregation "Shearith Israel" on Thursday Tishri 4th 5648 - Sept 22nd, 1889,"; "Address to the Wilfred Laurier March 15th, 1906," and "Barmitzvah Address to Philip Hart and Willie Solomon, Shabat Hanuckah, 5661".

32. Correspondence, Abraham de Sola

ca1870-1880

File consists of original correspondence including a large portion between Principal William Dawson and Abraham de Sola as well as other officials of McGill University concerning faculty business and affairs. Also includes documents and correspondence relating to the de Sola Lodge No 89 and the Grand Lodge, Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel, correspondence from Philadelphia concerning benevolent societies, and a pamphlet relating to "Rev. Dr. Lillenthal's Hebrew, Commercial, and Classical Boarding School."

33. Correspondence, Sir Moses Montefiore to Abraham de Sola 1862-1888

File consists of original correspondence mostly from Sir Moses Montefiore to Abraham de Sola.

34. Testimonial Letters for Abraham de Sola 1845-1850

File consists of a small notebook containing testimonial letters about Abraham de Sola's abilities as the Reverend of the Shearith Israel Synagogue (Montreal). Also included is a letter from Abraham de Sola's father (Rev. D.A. de Sola) regarding his candidature to the Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue in Montreal.

35. Opening of U.S. Congress by Abraham de Sola 1874

File consists of original correspondence with Abraham de Sola regarding his opening of the United States Congress in prayer in 1872. Also includes newspaper clippings related to this event.

36. Correspondence Abraham de Sola, Meldola de Sola 1873-1882

File contains correspondence to Abraham de Sola from the Grand Lodge, Ancient Jewish Order of Keshar Shel Barzel and communications concerning Aaron David Meldola de Sola's succession as Reverend of Shearith Israel (Montreal) following his father's death in 1882. As well, there is a handwritten copy of an article from the Canadian Illustrated News dated June 17, 1882 on the same topic.
