Biographical introduction Herman "Jackrabbit" Smith-Johannsen 1875-1987

Herman Smith-Johannsen was a pioneer in the sport of skiing in Quebec. He laid hundreds of miles of cross country ski trails in the Laurentian mountains north of Montréal and was involved in cross country skiing marathons even into his 107th year. He had some involvement in downhill skiing, encouraging his children to become involved at the Olympic level.

Herman was born in Norway on the 15th of June, 1875. He spent some time as a cadet in the Royal Norwegian Army Reserve before going on to the University of Berlin to study engineering in 1894. As a student he joined the fraternity, Berolina, adopting its motto "never rest and never rust" and acquiring the nickname "Jonas".

He arrived in the United States in 1901 to begin work at the Cleveland branch of The Brown Hoist Machinery Company. It was with this company that he travelled north and met the Cree Indians. They were so impressed with his method of travel - skiing - that they called him Okamacum Wapooes or Jackrabbit. While he was with the Brown Company, he met Alice Robinson (1882-1963), a kindergarten teacher whom he married on June 29th, 1907. In the mean time (1905), Herman had become a representative for the Browning Engineering Company and by the time he married, represented a number of other firms. As part of this line of work, he and Alice travelled throughout the United States and Canada selling machinery. In 1907 he set himself up as an independent agent selling machinery.

In 1908, the Johannsen's moved to Cuba, staying for three years until just after the birth of their first child, Alice, in 1911. In 1912, after a recuperation period in Norway, they returned to the United States and settled in New York for ten years, where two more children, Robert (Bob) and Margaret (Peggy) were born. Alice married R.S. Turnham and had no children. The third child, Margaret, married Peter Austin and had two children, Bob and Karen.

Herman had visited Canada as early as 1902 and in 1919 he set up an office 12 . . . Montreal. In 1922, Herman moved his family to Lake Placid and commuted to Montreal weekly. In 1928, the family moved to Westmount, and began spending much of their free time in the Laurentian ski areas north of Montréal.

The stock market crash of 1929 devastated the assets of the Johannsens. The family left Westmount for Shawbridge in the Laurentians. Herman maintained that the loss of his affluent lifestyle was a turning point in his life (Globe and Mail, August 28th, 1982)

Herman became famous for his determined longevity, continued skiing abilities and for his cheerful enthusiasm for skiing and a natural, healthy way of life. In 1969, at the age of 94, Herman was hearty enough to work his passage to Norway aboard the freighter Topdalsfjiord. He received the Order of Canada in 1972, and in 1974, the NFB made a film about him called "Jackrabbit". In 1975, Brian Powell published a compilation called <u>Jackrabbit: the first hundred</u> <u>years</u>. This was a series of recollections written by friends and collected by Powell, a long time friend. Herman appeared on several radio and television shows including "Front Page Challenge" and "Fresh Air". In this year, Johannsen took another trip to his native Norway; this time, though, it was on a cruise ship.

On another visit to Norway in 1987, he died of pneumonia on January 5th at the age of 111. His ashes were flown back to Canada so that he could be buried next to his wife, Alice according to his last request. The graves, in the cemetery at the church of St. Francis of the Birds in St. Sauveur, are marked by a granite boulder bearing their names and dates.

In 1992, the year of her death, Herman's daughter, Alice Johannsen, published <u>The Legendary Jackrabbit Johannsen</u> (McGill-Queen's University Press).

Custodial history

These records were given to the Archives by Peggy Austin upon the death of her sister Alice Johannsen (1911-1991). The material has been sorted into the papers of Herman "Jackrabbit" Johannsen and those of Alice who was the director of the University Museums for some years and later director of the Gault Estate.

Jackrabbit's papers had been kept by Alice since before her father's death. In Alice's own papers are some collected files relating to her father. These include chronologies of his life and "Dad's journals" (summaries of journals (1906-07) which no longer exist, and summaries of journals (1948-1962) in the collection). These biographical notes presumably served as aids during the writing of <u>The</u> <u>Legendary Jackrabbit Johannsen</u>.

Jackrabbit and Alice spent much time together in their later years. Alice was able to aid Herman in organizing his various activities and related paper work. Researchers should look through her papers for additional information on her father.

Scope and Content

The papers of "Jackrabbit" Johannsen reflect his personal, professional and recreational activities, mainly between 1934 and 1985. The largest part of the papers consists of correspondence with friends and organizations, particularly relating to skiing and outdoor life. Family relations are also covered. A series of brief journals provides a record of some of his daily activities, from 1948 to 1984. The remainder of the fonds include publications about Johannsen, photographs, maps and personal documents such as passports.

Series

Correspondence

This series consists of correspondence, 1934-1985. The correspondence files are for the most part kept by subject or sender and are arranged in chronological order.

Files 28-46, 49-67, 72-93, 96-208, 218, 234, 236. Textual records. Extent: 1.4 metres linear

The main subjects are as follows:

Sports associations:

Quebec Winter Sports Association (1937-1941), Ski Touring Council (1968-1975), Canadian Olympic Association (1974-1982), Norwegian Olympic Working Committee (1976-1977), and the Holmenkollen Ski Festival in Norway (1979-1980).

Ski clubs:

Hillcrest Ski Club (1939-1941), Red Birds Ski Club (1959-1982), The Viking Ski Club (1968-1982), The Ull Ski Club (1968-1976), Laurentian Lodge Club (1945-1976), Sun Valley (1968-1974), and McGill Outing Club (1970-1975).

Various ski activities and marathons:

Canadian Ski Marathon (1967-1982), Jackrabbit Ski League (1982-1983).

Ski museums:

Canadian Ski Museum and Jackrabbit Laurentian Ski Museum (1979-1985).

Awards:

The Order of Canada (1973, 1978-1982), St. Olav medal from King Olav of Norway (1980-1983), honorary degrees from Sir George Williams University (1968) and McGill University (1975), Canadian Achievers Dinner (1980-82).

Works about Jackrabbit, media events:

National Film Board film (1974), television program Front Page Challenge (1975), <u>Jackrabbit: the first hundred years</u> (1979-1981).

Outdoor activities:

Trail clearing in Quebec and Ontario (1962-1976), canoeing, hunting and fishing (1960-62).

Travels:

Travels were most frequently in Norway (1933-1980).

Non-skiing activities:

Involvement in the Norwegian Seamen's Church (1967-1977), Sedburgh School (1947-1975), Boy Scouts (1950-1963) and his fraternity, Berolina (1963-1979).

Scrapbook

A scrapbook commemorates Jackrabbit's 90th birthday in 1965. It is composed of collected anecdotes, photographs (1930-1965) and correspondence. Handwritten markers have been placed in the book. These were possibly written by Alice in her research for the book <u>The Legendary Jackrabbit</u> <u>Johannsen</u>.

Correspondence - 100th birthday

A separate series has been created for correspondence relating to Jackrabbit's 100th birthday in 1975. It includes telegrams from Gerald Ford, Pierre Trudeau and others as well as assorted fan mail. Files 137-142. Textual records and approx. 20 photographs Extent: .07 m.

Journals

This series of Johannsen's journals (1948-1984) record his day to day activities and are not contemplative in nature. One (for 1967) is in Norwegian. Files 1-25, 27, 47. Textual records. Extent: .2 m.

Personal documents

These consist of passports, other travel documents and family papers, (1980-1985). Files 219-221. Textual records. Extent: .06 m.

Newsclippings and articles

Most of the newsclippings in this collection are about ski related activities such as the Jackrabbit Ski League, various competitions, or about Herman's great longevity. They range from 1966-67 and 1974-1981. Files 94-95, 209-217. Textual records. Extent: .2 m.

Maps and information

These include maps made by or used by Johannsen for trails and other purposes. Files 68-71. Textual records. Extent: .1 m.

Photographs

There are many photographs, mostly black and white, (1929-1935, 1967-1984). Many of them can be identified in Alice Johannsen's book or within the scrapbook or the files themselves. Some of these photographic prints are also in the Archives photographic inventory. Subject matter ranges from skiing events and family gatherings to miscellaneous prints sent by fans. Many are snapshots but there are a number of press photographs. Files 222-232.
